It has been a privilege to serve the APUO as Secretary / Treasurer for the last three years and I hope that you trust me to continue in this role. Since 2017 I have taken my role seriously, working with the APUO team to develop the budget and present the audited financial statements to the Executive, the Board and the General Membership. Over the course of the last three years working closely with APUO staff we have established a Financial Reserves Policy, selected a new auditing firm resulting in cost savings for the association, a selected an investment services firm to actively manage the association's reserve funds resulting in increased investment revenues. In the most recent year as Treasurer I have continued in my active participation in union activities while on Academic Leave. If elected to continue as Treasurer I hope to continue work already underway with APUO staff to regarding accessibility upgrades to the APUO offices, monitor and communicate how the financial situation of the University affects our working conditions and our students learning conditions, and engage with members and the Executive Committee on the issues directly affecting our membership particularly those around workload and governance.
