
## **Sectoral Occupational Health and Safety Committees**



Sector 1 Downtown Campus North (pink area) 3 APUO seats	Downtown Campus North is the northern geographic zone on the downtown campus and consists of buildings and operations therein north of Marie-Curie Private (with the exception of Facilities - refer to the sector 3 committee, and the Montpetit, Lamoureux/Learning Crossroads, Vanier, and Faculty of Social Sciences buildings).
Sector 2 Downtown Campus South (green area) 2 APUO seats	Downtown Campus South is the southern geographic zone on the downtown campus consists of buildings and operations therein south of Marie-Curie Private (with the exception of Facilities - refer to the sector 3 committee, and includes the Montpetit, Lamoureux/Learning Crossroads, Vanier, and Faculty of Social Sciences buildings).
Sector 3 Facilities and Protection 1 APUO seat	This SOHSC consists of all spaces traditionally restricted to Facilities and Protection Services in all buildings on the Downtown campus. The committee represents all workers employed by Facilities and Protection Services, respectively, regardless of their principal work location(s), and focuses on the work, hazards, and risks faced by those persons who conduct unique and specific roles within Facilities and Protection Services.
Sector 4 Alta Vista Campus (orange area) 2 APUO seats	Alta Vista consists of buildings and operations therein located at the Alta Vista Campus, such as Roger Guindon Hall as well as 600 and 850 Peter Morand.

Sector 5 Rideau River Campus (Lees Avenue) (purple area) 2 APUO seats  Sector 6 Off-campus (Yellow area – not all locations are shown on the map) 1 APUO seat	This SOHSC consists of buildings and activities located on the Lees Avenue campus, including the Faculty of Health Sciences as well as the sport installations.  Off-Campus consists of University owned and leased buildings and operations therein located at satellite buildings not part of the University's three campuses (i.e., Downtown, Lees, or Alta Vista). Workplaces included in the sector 6 committee include the Library Annex, the storage at Algoma Street, the Telfer Executive Program at 99 Bank, the Kanata North Campus, and residences located off-campus, including the Annexe, Friel, Rideau, and Mann.
Sector 7 Psychological health and safety 2 APUO seats	The Psychological H&S committee consists of all areas within the University and is dedicated to psychological health and safety. The role of the committee is to identify and assess sources of psychological hazards and make recommendations to the employer for improvement in psychological health and safety.
